Radiation Safety VT 109 Distance Learning (on-line course) 2 credits

Introduces x-radiation and safety principles involved in using x-ray machines. The course satisfies the State of Oregon requirements for licensure to work with x-ray machines in a veterinary hospital or clinic setting. The next course will be offered Winter term (January 8th-March 24th) in an online, self-paced format.

Please note, there is no specific text required for this course – all educational material is provided in the online format.

Prerequisite: Admission to the Veterinary Technology Program OR current employment in a veterinary facility doing x-ray work is required.

Cost: PCC's cost per credit is \$104.00. There are a few other fees associated with the registration process making the overall cost for this course to be approximately \$260.00
